Job Overview

 - Support the Agile Team in agreed upon achievable PI Objectives.

Iteration Planning

- Prepare for Iteration Planning, including:
 - Actively participate in backlog refinement sessions in collaboration with other Agile team members.
 - Actively participate in team planning and contributing to team goals.
 - Volunteer for and commit to delivering stories and tasks within the sprint.

Enable Agility

- Learn the principles behind the Agile Manifesto in all interactions.
- Work within a self-directed Agile team; learn from team members and assigned mentor, commit to work and contribute to the outcome.
- Cultivate a passion for delivering high quality products aligned with customer needs.



- Employ continuous learning; build domain expertise.
- Actively communicate and collaborate within the team.
